

Mentoring- An Overview

- The Purpose of mentoring is to make the students to adapt the new environment and academic schedule, to understand the needs of curriculum, to develop healthy interpersonal relationship and also for personality development.
- Keeping the parents informed about the attendance and performance of their wards from time to time and guiding the students to choose right career paths for jobs, higher studies, entrepreneurship etc, is the prime motto.

- Students attendance in every class is to be collected after each class so that if a student is absent for more than 5 classes in any subject continuously, the mentor will inform the parents of the student concerned and enquire the reason.
- The mentors meet the students associated with them once in every month.
- Each mentor will update students performance to the Departmental Coordinator and HOD

Structure of Mentoring Cell

- Convener
- Departmental Coordinators(From each department)
- One mentor approximately for 20 students

Activity

- Since the majority of the students are not matured enough to take their own decision in the vast changing of technology and their family and educational background
- For each 20 students, one teacher-mentor is allotted. A register to record the communication with the parents is placed.
- Advanced tutorials are arranged by the mentors in association with the respective subject teachers and experts focusing problem-based learning of modern technology.
