Swachh Bharat Abhiyan (SBA) or Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM) is a nationwide campaign in India for the period 2014 to 2019 that aims to clean up the streets, roads and infrastructure of India's cities, towns and rural areas. Students of MBA conducted a programme on 20th November, 2014 about Green City Clean city.

This campaign was officially launched on 2rd October, 2014 at Rajghat, New Delhi by our Hon'ble Prime Minister Narendra Modi garu. It is India's largest cleanliness drive to date with three million government employees and students from all part of India participating in 4041 cities, towns and rural areas. Shri Narendra Modi has called the campaign Satyagarh se Swachhgarh in reference to Gandhi's Champaran Satyagraha launched on 10rd April, 1917.



Students conducted cleanliness drive which was a one day programme for creating awareness among the public about the cleanliness and keeping surroundings clean and green. In this regard, Vaagdevi College of Engineering promote Swachh Bharat Abhiyan. On this occasion faculty and students of the department had participated in



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this campaign. They had taken oath to make and keep campus clean. They had also cleared the campus on this occasion.
