About 1/3rd of cancer cases could be reduced if cases are treated and detected at an early stage.

A famous cancer specialist by name Dr. Avinath Tippam, Around 160 students along with faculty were participated to create awareness regarding reasons for stress in human who leads to cancer. The main objectives of the programme are to create awareness of the disease. To help people recognize the early signs and symptoms of cancer.

The programme encourages the participants to seek prompt medical attention for symptoms which may include lumps, sores, bleeding, hoarseness, weight loss and persistent indigestion/cough/pain, etc.

To educate people about the key risk factors of cancer since more than 30% of cancer cases could be prevented by modifying lifestyle or avoiding the key risk factors. To inform people about the importance of cancer check-ups at an early stage.
