The following decisions are taken

- After considering the minutes of the respective Boards of Studies the CAC has Approved the course structure and syllabi of B.Tech III & IV Years (V, VI, VII & VIII Semesters) for Civil, EEE, Mech, ECE, CSE, CSE(AI&ML) and CSE(DS) branches under R20-CBCS scheme.
- 2. Approved the syllabi of Advance English Communications Skills Lab.
- 3. Approved all the Academic Calendars Regular & Revised for the Academic Year-2021-22.
- 4. JNTUH granted the approval for the B.Tech Minor courses. It is noted and approved for the implementation of B.Tech Degree with Minor in the Emerging areas from the Academic Year 2021-22.
- 5. Approved to conduct Exams for improvement of Internal marks to UG (B.Tech)students with following conditions.
 - a. The students who secure internal marks less than the marks specified are only eligible to write the exam for improvement of internal marks. This specified marks can be computed using the formula: **0.4** x **TotalMarks -0.35** x **Externalmarks.**
 - b. In addition to those who completed double the duration plus two years, all the candidates who completed their course work but having backlogs are eligible to write internals exams for improvement in case the internal marks secured by the candidate is less than the marks specified as above.
 - c. Only one chance must be given to write Internal exams for instance a student is eligible to write Internal Improvement exam in ten subjects, he can register for some subjects in the current spell and remaining subjects in the subsequent spells.
 - d. If the new marks are less than the old internal marks or registered but not attended exam, the old internal marks will be retained, as it is an internal improvement examination.

6. It is approved that the students admitted in II-Year B.Tech programme under R18 & R20 regulations through Lateral Entry scheme has to acquire the following number of credits for the award of the degree as envisaged by the AICTE model curriculum-2018. However this rule is applicable to R18 and R20 regulations henceforth.

- 7. It is approved that maximum period of course completion is extended for another two years for UG and one year for PG courses for students admitted under R14 & R15 regulations who failed to obtain the degree even after permitted with 8 and 6 academic years for UG and PG students respectively.
- 8. It is approved to increase the grace marks in one or two subjects from 8 to 10 to pass the subject(s) for UG students, as the JNTUH has implemented the same.
- 9. It is approved to rename the title of the subject "Managerial Economics and Financial Accountancy" to "Managerial Economics and Financial Analysis" for the B.Tech-CSE, B.Tech-CSE(AI&ML) and B.Tech-CSE(DS) branches to have uniformity with the other B.Tech branches.
- 10. It is approved to use relevant open source softwares in all Laboratories. This is applicable to R18 & R20 regulations and henceforth.

The CAC has resolved to change the academic calendars by the Chairman, CAC in exigencies.
